EVENING WORSHIP

The Sheep & the Goats – Matthew 25:31-46

Jesus shares this story days before His Crucifixion – this could have been
Jesus' final teaching in the Jerusalem Temple.

The separation between the sheep and goats is based on **Ezekiel 34:17-19**
Sheep and goats would be in the pasture together and freely intermingle.
From a distance, they would look similar in appearance.

The sheep are on the right and the goats are to Jesus' left.

The sheep are surprised in **v. 37** to learn they ministered to Jesus.

Our ministry to "the least of these" are acts of mercy that Christ takes
personal.

- The recipient of the ministry are "these brothers and sisters of mine." **v. 40**
- The sheep are those who responded properly to Christ's messengers and His message. We're to show mercy to fellow believers.

This example from Jesus is **not a social Gospel message** ministering to
the poor throughout the world.

Jesus is saying **sheep help fellow believers** – when we do this we're
ministering to Jesus.

MORNING WORSHIP

Palm Sunday: Your King is Coming – Matthew 21:1-17

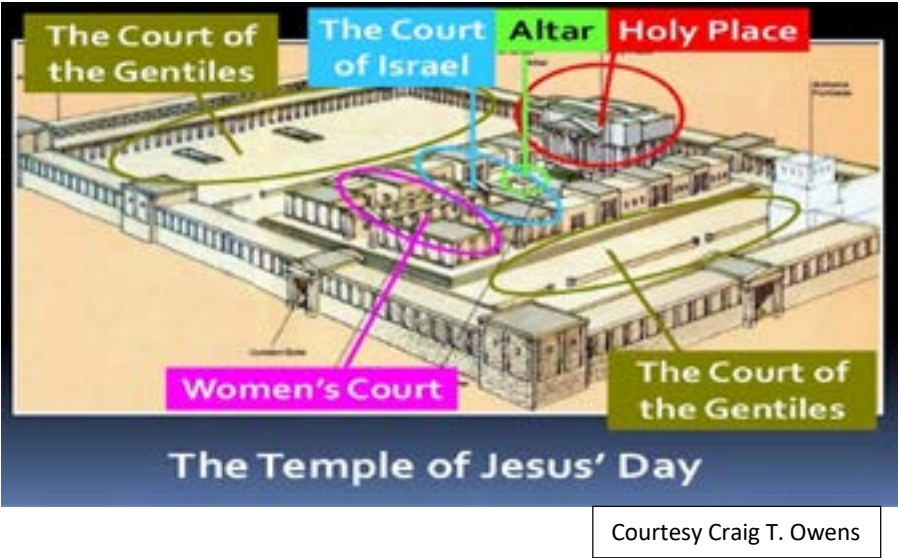
When Jesus rode into Jerusalem, people laid down their cloaks on the road in front of him and hailed him as a King coming in the name of the house of David.

- This would have been culturally appropriate in that day: a king would ride into town publicly and be hailed by a cheering crowd.
- What was different about Jesus entering Jerusalem, was He didn't ride on a large horse, rather a colt, or small donkey.

Jesus arrives at the temple and business operations were going on – it was a place of buying and selling.

The area of the temple you first walked into was called, “the Court of the Gentiles” – it was the only part where non-Jews were located.

- Jesus’ reaction was to start throwing furniture over. He’s clearing the temple for Gentiles – He’s their advocate.
- The outer court was the only place the Gentiles could pray and it had become a flea market.
