Developing a Righteous Conscience – 1 Samuel 24:1-11

Background:

- David had been anointed by the prophet Samuel to become the next king, but things aren't going well.
- Saul, who is David's father-in-law, and King of Israel, is on a hunt to kill David. Saul is jealous of David.
- David secretly cut the corner of Saul's robe off and he fell under conviction.

Situation:

- David's **desire** and his **circumstances** are driving him to murder King Saul.
- David's acquaintances are encouraging him to murder Saul.
- It's easy to confuse our **desires** and our **circumstances** with the will of God.
- Neither our **desires** or our **circumstances** are good guides to the will of God.
- Killing Saul would have solved many of David's problems, but you cannot achieve God's will by breaking God's commands.

Takeaways:

- ◆ Doing wickedness, makes one wicked no matter how justified you feel while doing it. This is why revenge is a sin. **Romans 12:17-19**
- ◆ While in this cave, David wrote **Psalms 57**. God reminded David of his purpose in the cave. **Psalms 57:2**
- ◆ Our conscience can't be guided by desires or circumstances.
