MORNING WORSHIP

Upsidedown – Jesus & Nicodemus – John 3:1-21

Main Conversational Point – Only new birth guarantees salvation.

Nicodemus believed he would be saved through obeying the Old Testament laws.

Context – Nicodemus was committed to Judaism. He’s a Pharisee. This was a group of around 6,000 men who sought to obey every single Old Testament commandment.

- The Old Testament has 613 commandments – 248 dos and 365 don'ts. When you became a Pharisee, you pledge in front of 3 witnesses to uphold every detail of the law for the rest of your life.
- The Pharisees were so committed to obeying each command they developed additional commands based on the original 613 commandments to ensure they didn't mistakenly violate the originals.

Not only was Nicodemus a Pharisee, but a member of the 70-man Sanhedrin, led by the high priest.

The Sanhedrin served as the governing body of Israel.

- Nicodemus was a man of influence – in **John 7:50**, he would argue for a fair hearing of Jesus.
- After Jesus died, Nicodemus became a public disciple. He wrapped Jesus' body with linen cloths with a mixture of 75 pounds of myrrh and aloes. (**John 19:39-40**).

Takeaways:

1. Jesus is teaching Nicodemus that following external laws will not be enough to go to heaven.
2. Jesus taught Nicodemus that he needed an internal transformation. This is what it means to be, “Born Again.”
