Trying to Influence God – 1 Kings 14:1-20

Abijah is the son of Jeroboam, and became sick.

Jeroboam turned to Ahijah, the true prophet, for the Lord to heal his son. He knew his false prophets couldn't help him.

Abijah's sickness was an opportunity to Jeroboam to repent. Instead, the king turned to deceit to buy favor to God. He thought a gift would help his son live.

- God knew Abijah's heart, he received a proper burial. Out of wicked Jeroboam's house, his son was good. **1 Kings 14:13**
- God uses sickness and tragedy to speak to us.

John MacArthur wrote of King Jeroboam, "He had installed a paganized system of worship for the entire population of the northern kingdom."

Jeroboam began a pattern of wickedness that could not influence God except with repentance.

Takeaways:

1. God speaks to us in times of difficulty. (son was sick)
2. God speaks to us in times of national crisis. (the prince died)

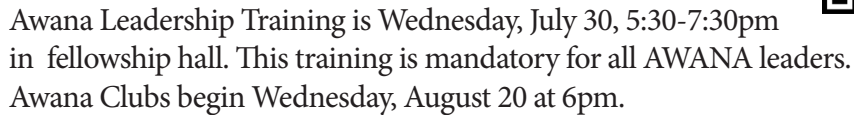
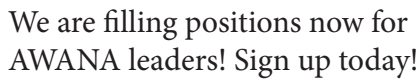
