EVENING WORSHIP

Becoming A Man After God's Own Heart
1 Samuel 13:13-14; 16:7; Psalm 89:19-29; Acts 13:22

- When you think of men and women in the Bible, only David is called a man after God's own heart.
- David was an adulterer and murderer, yet he's the only one who sought God's heart.
 - David lived in a deep abiding relationship with His Heavenly Father. He saw God in everything that happened to him, good and bad.

- What are the qualities of David who sought God's heart?
- 1). He spent time with God. He was still and quiet before God. **Psalm 37:7**
 - 2). He was excited about trusting God. **Psalm 37:5**
 - 3). David had a strong desire to obey God. What is David's spirit when he was confronted with sin? **2 Samuel 12:11-14**
 - 4). David possessed a servant's attitude. Why would God want David to have a servant's spirit? A rebellious spirit works against you all your life. **1 Samuel 24:5-7; Psalm 89:20**

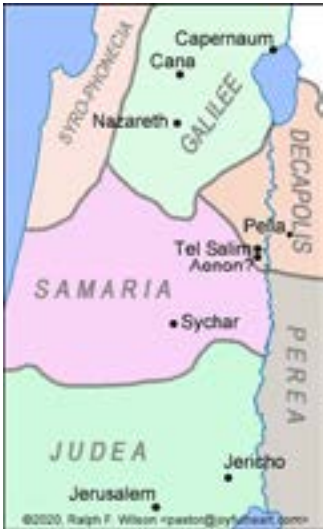
MORNING WORSHIP

John 4:1-40 – Upsidedown – Jesus & the Samaritan Woman

The comparison between Nicodemus (John 3) and the Samaritan Woman (John 4) are two completely different people who both need Jesus.

Where is Samaria? It was an area of land between Judea and Galilee.

Jesus is headed north to Galilee and passes through a Samaritan town called, Sychar. Jacob's well was there.



How does Jesus give this unnamed woman “living water?”

1. Jesus exposes her spiritual thirst. **v. 10**
2. Jesus offers her living water. **v. 14**
3. The woman wants Jesus' living water. **v. 15**

The conversation then shifts from “living water” to the woman’s many husbands and then to true worship in spirit and in truth.

- This woman likely is the first person to proclaim the Gospel outside of Judea. **v. 29** She didn't even know Jesus' name. The world's first evangelist was an unlikely Samaritan Woman who received "living water."
