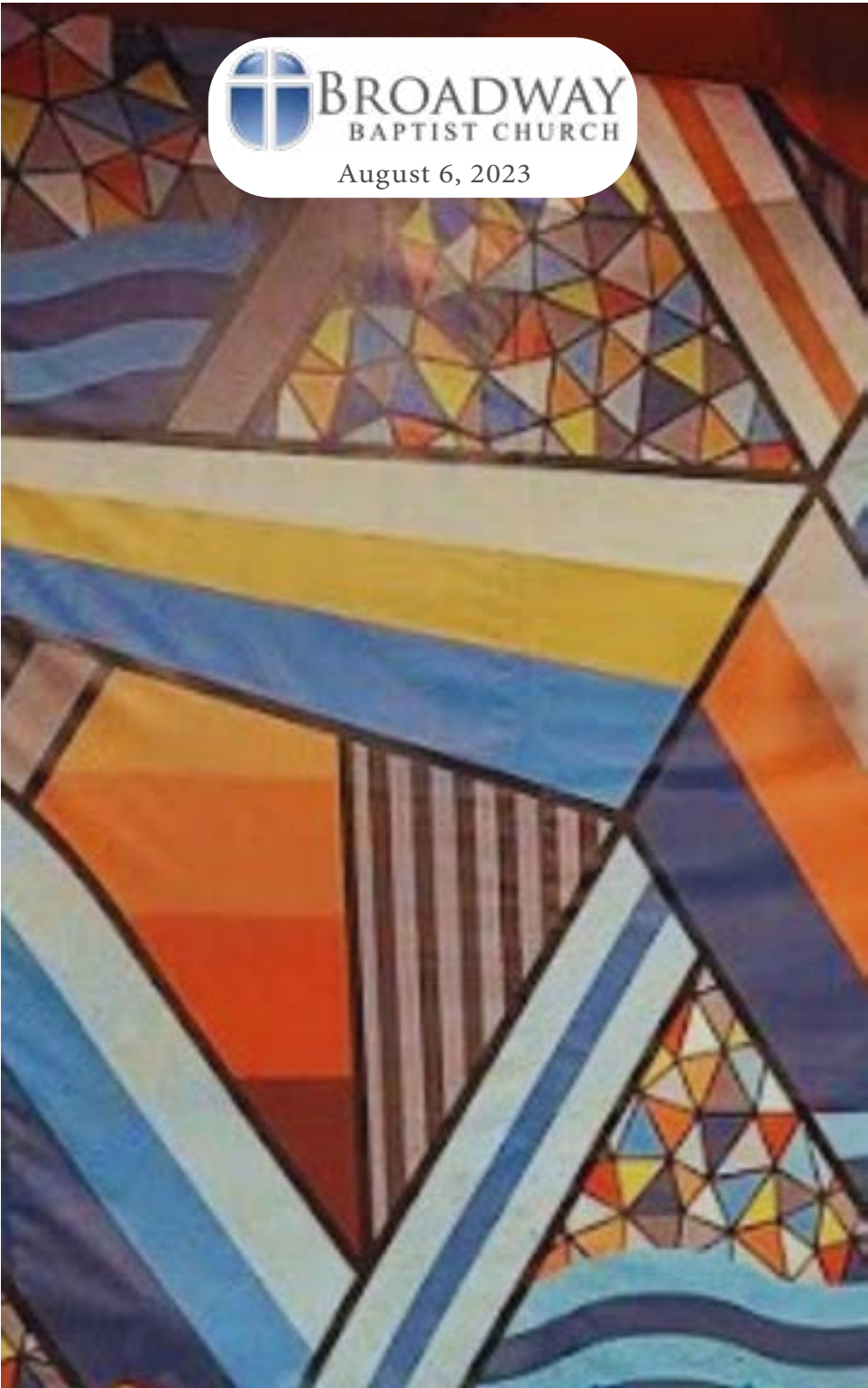

MORNING WORSHIP

Upsidedown – Jesus & Lazarus – John 11:1-44

The Family: Mary, Martha & Lazarus

- Mary anointed Jesus with an alabaster jar. She was the one sitting at Jesus' feet, listening to Him.
- Martha was a servant, distracted with her many task.

The Plan: Mary & Martha need Jesus to see their brother, Lazarus, before he dies. Even though their plan failed, Jesus had something better than their plan.

The Problem: We're tempted to believe what we can figure out. Logic can't account for the plan of God. Logic keeps us from seeing the work of God.

- There is one purpose of Lazarus' illness: To glorify Jesus and His Father. His sickness is for God's glory.
- Jesus uses Lazarus' death to display His power over death. Jesus brings the dead to life.

How does this apply:

- The sisters believed Jesus was too late.
- We *have* life, Jesus *is* life.
- We place our trust in a Man who can bring Lazarus to life and who Himself was resurrected.

The last thing any person wants to do is give up control. Death removes your control, Jesus has control over death.

He is in total control of Lazarus' sickness, the sister's pain, and when Jesus calls Lazarus out of the tomb.

Upsidedown: When we learn to trust Jesus, we will experience things we would have never experienced on our own.
