Burn Out or Rust Out for Jesus? **2 Corinthians 4:7-18**

There's an emphasis on service among believers, but we can't view serving the Lord as we give Him everything until we have nothing left to give.

Why do believers "**burn out**?"

- Because they have "stalled out" in their personal relationship with God. Being burned out is reflected of your spiritual life. If you have a vibrant prayer and worship life, you can continue to serve.

Why do believers "**rust out**?"

- The phrase of describing church members as "inactive" means they're not serving. Rusty believers aren't serving the Lord – they might be busy with other things, but not Christian service.
- Burn out can lead to rusting out. Either way, you're out. Christians can find themselves on the sidelines after years of not serving.
- A better way to grasp serving the Lord is to "burn on." Christ does not give us a burden we cannot carry. **Matthew 11:28-30**

How to Pray – Jesus' Model – Matthew 6:5-15

Why is the Lord's Prayer important?

Christians pray this prayer as a way to learn how to pray and what to pray. [How](#) & [What](#)

Prayerlessness reveals pride. Many Christians and churches have given up on prayer. How? Because Christians lack the desperation that has existed throughout church history.

- If you're "getting by" and "everything's okay" – there's a temptation for the distracted not to pray.
- Martin Luther said distraction is the greatest enemy to prayer. The purpose of the Lord's Prayer is to teach Christians how to pray.

4 steps to develop your prayer life (from Adrian Rogers):

1. You must establish a proper priority.
2. You must express a prayerful petition.
3. You must exercise a personal performance.
4. You must enjoy a present provision.

Jesus is heaven's bread for earth's hunger.

Some people don't have their needs met because they don't ask.

Albert Mohler said prayer is **not** these things:

- It is not **self-expression**. We do not approach God in any way we see fit.
- It is not an act of **therapy**. We are not receiving a kickback when we pray.
- It is not an act of **manipulation**. We are not trying to persuade God.
- It is not a **news report**. Prayer does not inform God what He does not know.
