

MORNING WORSHIP

Can Prayer Change the Will of God? - Genesis 18:16-33

Malachi 3:6 "I the Lord, have not changed."

Why was God willing to spare Sodom if He found ten righteous people?

- Abraham and God have an unique negotiation about the righteous and the wicked.
- If God knows the future and he knows what's going to happen why pray?

Prayer is allowing us to be used by God – God was willing to save Sodom for ten people because Abraham asked.

Four Reasons we Pray:

- 1. God is eternal. His perfect plan blends with God's purposes at work with our prayers.
- 2. God is not limited as we are. He is not bound by time and space.
- 3. God's plan involves our response to Him. Genesis 1:27
- 4. God created us with the freedom to choose our desire to worship and live for Him, or rebel against Him.

A way to understand prayer is that we're independent and we're dependent upon Him.

- Prayer is when you open the door so God can come in and take what you've done and use it beyond your imagination.
- Prayer open ourselves to being used. It's saying, "God I have nothing. Let's see what you're going to do with nothing."

Paul prayed in **Colossians 1:9** for believers to be filled with the knowledge of God's will.

This means the will of God is something believers must search and know. Abraham did not know how God would respond about Sodom until he asked.
