

MORNING WORSHIP

The Peace That Only God Can Give - Isaiah 26:3-4; Romans 5:1-5

Having a desire for God is rooted in the knowledge that God's peace is best.

God is peace. That is an old and simple statement that never loses its truth or power.

Peace is the third fruit of the Spirit. Galatians 5:22

Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Don't let your heart be troubled or fearful." John 14:27

When we experience a great loss – the pain can be all-consuming, making us feel paralyzed and hopeless. However, when we trust God and fully embrace Jesus' love, we can experience God's peace no matter what has happened.

- Peace is a soothing word that gives us the ability to remain calm even in the middle of a storm.
- You can't fully describe God's peace. You can sense it, you can own it, but it's almost impossible to articulate. God gives us just when we need it most.
