

Our Attitude Towards Godliness - Proverbs 9:10

In the "old days" people were referred to as, "a God-fearing man" or "a God-fearing woman."

- Having a fear of God is a reverence for God. Christians have this
 reverence that impacts the way they live. This is the beginning
 place for spiritual growth.
- Whenever we yield to the fear of man, it takes us out of the wisdom of God.

Proverbs 29:25 declares that yielding to the fear of man will ensnare us. It will bring us into bondage, costing us wisdom from God.

Four ways our attitude towards God impacts us:

- 1). Respect for Him. We don't speak of God casually. Exodus 20:7
- 2). Obey God's Word. We allow Scripture to guide our decisions. **Psalm** 119:9-11
- 3). We submit to God's discipline. Hebrews 12:8
- 4). We maintain an awe of God this is our worship. Hebrews 12:28

"Every truth revealed in God's Word is there not only for our information, but for our inspiration." – Arthur Pink

How a believer speaks about the Lord reveals their attitude about Him.

- → Awe of God is a high emotion. It is one of the emotions that distinguishes humanity from the animal creation. Animals don't look off into the sunset with wonder and awe in their eyes.
- → God's creation and wonder is a motivating factor for us to surrender to Christ. **Romans 1:18-23**

Without the fear of the Lord, we may gain knowledge of earthly things and make some practical choices, but we are missing the one ingredient that defines a wise person – the reverence of God.
