#### Family Among a Fallen World – Hebrews 12:14-29

Family is difficult because we live in a fallen world.

Spiritual warfare attacks families because it's an attack on God. Family is one of the three institutions created by God, along with government and the church.

The three examples of family problem here:

- Esau sold his birthright to his brother Jacob.
- Abel was killed by his brother Cain.

Family points beyond itself to the truth about humanity – we have been crucified with Christ (**Galatians 2:20**). He must come before them.

Christians who put family first will soon find itself uncomfortable with Jesus.

- → If we do not bear our own cross, we cannot be a disciple of Christ (Luke 14:27).
- → Our love for Jesus should be so overwhelming, it makes our family relationships look like hate (**Luke 14:26**)
- → If we love Jesus more than our family, we are then freed to love our families more that we could otherwise.


