The Danger of Drifting from Scripture – Jude 1:20-25

If you ever walk out into the ocean, spend several minutes in the water, look back at the beach – you’ve drifted from where you entered.

Drift can happen in our theological beliefs.

You grew up hearing that:

- Divorce is wrong. **Mark 10:9**
- Alcohol is sinful. **Ephesians 5:18**
- Those of other faiths are not saved. **John 14:6**

How does the drift from Scripture occur?

1. You have a friend or family member who is in sin, yet they’re “a good and nice person.” The sin becomes personal in your life.
2. You were once around the constant teaching, preaching, and study of Scripture – but for various reasons, now you’re not.
3. Those who don’t profess Christ as their Savior – you no longer look for opportunities to share Jesus with this. Evangelism isn’t something you pray for an opportunity anymore.

Christianity isn’t a private, personal faith. It’s a missionary-fueled desire to see the one lost sheep saved. **Luke 15:4**

MORNING WORSHIP

The Godliness of the Priesthood – Exodus 19:3-6; 28:1-5

Aaron was Moses' older brother, by three years. He was from the tribe of Levi.

Levites were those who descended from the tribe of Levi. The Levites were chosen by God to serve as priests. Not all Levites were priests.

Priests were men selected from the Levites to serve as tabernacle or temple worship. They had to be descendants of Aaron and his four sons.

Priests and Levites had a specific calling of serving the Lord. Levites served the tabernacle and temple, only priests could make sacrifices.

God's holiness involves two things:

- Separation from something
- Devotion to something else

We separate from everything evil or ordinary.

The priesthood in the Old Testament begins with **Melchizedek**, king of Salem. **Genesis 14:20**

Melchizedek was the priest of the most high God whom Abram brought the first tithe. Melchizedek is a priest forever. **Hebrews 6:20**

The office of priest is connected to sacrificing, in that case Abel made the first sacrifice. **Genesis 4:4**

- Noah, Abraham, and Jethro (Moses' father-in-law) all brought sacrifices to God. The sacrificial system is fulfilled in Christ. We no longer have to bring a sacrifice to the temple.
- The formal priesthood accompanies formal worship. The priesthood is fulfilled in Christ. **Hebrews 5:4-6**
