EVENING WORSHIP

Romans 13:1-7 - How Believer's Respond to War

War has broken out in Israel. Many of us might be wondering, "What do I do?"

Thousands of people will die and many of these people do not have personal relationships with Christ.

How should a believer respond to war?

- 1. Recognize that God established government and government has the responsible to "carry the sword." **Genesis 9:5-6**; **Romans 13:4**
- 2. Government has the responsibility to confront evil. Believers should pray for leaders to make just decisions regarding war.
- 3. We support and give to humanitarian aid. Civilians will die, refugees will increase, and there will be massive medical care needs.
- 4. We pray for the expansion of the Gospel during war. Uncertainty and need draws people to Christ.

It's easy to become focused on the End Times during war in Israel, but our focus should be seeing the Gospel advance during war.

The Middle East is ground zero for End Times events – we must remember, God is at work during times of war.

Family – God's First Institution

God has created only three institutions:

- 1. Family Genesis 1:27-28; 2:20-25
- 2. Government Genesis 9:5-6
- 3. Church **Matthew 16:17-19**

Being able to change is an important truth. Your role in a family changes. I (your pastor) am a husband, father, son, brother, uncle, nephew, cousin, and in-law. I hold all those roles in a family.

Have you ever been told, "Don't even try to change your husband (wife) because he (she) will never change." Hearing those dire predictions repeatedly can make you feel hopeless.

Four Important Truths about Change:

- 1) Everyone needs to change. Romans 3:21-23
- 2) Every person can change.
- It's not that a person can't change. It's that they don't want to.
 Or they don't make the effort to do anything differently than they always have.
- 3) Marriage creates the perfect opportunity for change.
- When you're married, you find out how much you need to improve. Each of us always needs to change, some more than others, but God will start with the one who is willing. This is where His blessings will be directed first.
- 4) People cannot make someone else change.
- Our job is not to change our spouse, it's the work of the Holy Spirit. No amount of criticizing and nagging will accomplish it. God made us in His image, and He doesn't want us to try and make our spouse over into our own image.
