

## MORNING WORSHIP

### The Bible's Greatest Chapter - Romans 8:1-11

Romans 8 is important because it teaches us what we have in Christ. As believer's in Christ we always have:

- 1. The indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Freedom from sin and death.
- 3. A new mindset.

Main point: We cannot please God in the flesh. v. 8

This chapter begins with "no condemnation" v. 1 and concludes with no separation from God. v. 39

When you're looking for hope and Scripture to memorize, Romans 8 makes us thankful for what God has done.

There are two categories of people. These categories are based on people's mindset. **v. 6** 

- Flesh = death
- Spirit = life & peace

You are either alive to God or you're dead to sin. Romans 6:11

- → In the Old Testament, salvation was obeying the law. Jesus freed us from the law, we now live in the Spirit. Our identity isn't based on our obedience to the law, rather in Christ alone.
- → Romans 8 teaches us that Christian holiness isn't about conformity to external laws, rather it's the Holy Spirit producing fruit in a believer's life.
- → The law prescribed holiness, but it was powerless to produce such a life.

How do you know you're saved? The mark of the Holy Spirit – we "walk" according to the Spirit. **v. 4**
