Esther 1:1-22 – Prepared for Your Moment

Esther is the only book of the Bible that doesn't mention God by name.

God whole plan of making Esther pretty, Esther being chosen, Esther being for a spiritual reason – Esther is here at this time, for this purpose. Esther is being prepared for her moment.

Esther's cousin, Mordecai makes the main point in **Esther 4:14**, "Who knows, perhaps you have come to your royal position for such a time as this."

A moment is when you realize God has you where you are for a purpose. He's been preparing you for Him.

The circumstances of Esther reveal the providence of God.

Esther is in Persia – in exile. She's an orphan, being raised by her cousin, Mordecai.

While in exile, Esther didn't:

1. Adore worldly temptations.
2. Awe at worldly wealth.
3. Afraid of worldly kings.

Greatness in God's Kingdom wanting to see what God will do. Mordecai knew deliverance would come, Esther could be used or someone else. **Esther 4:14**
