

The Bible's Greatest Chapter - Romans 8:18-30

Paul has given us the best news in the first 17 verses. We do not have to struggle in defeat – the power of sin and death have been nullified.

Groan is the wait. We live in the midst of pain.

Glory is our redemption. It's where the Christian is headed.

Believers are not promised easy an easy life. We walk the path of our Lord, which is suffering.

Paul list three groanings:

1	vv. 19-22
2	vv. 23-25
3.	vv. 26-28

- God's action is subjecting the creation to futility and groaning and corruption.
- When Adam sinned, death and suffering and futility and groaning came into the world. Why? Because God said it would. Eat of this tree and you will die. Genesis 2:16-17

Christians should not fall for the trap to remove God because of suffering from the world.

Creation teaches us that suffering, pain, sin, and death will continue – it never gets better. **v. 22**

- ightarrow We now await the Second Coming of Christ or our redemption upon our passing.
- → Complaining about our world is futile, it never gets better. The Spirit was given to us as we groan – the Spirit intercedes for us because we won't.

The goodness of God has taken groaning and glory and worked it for His purpose and our good.
