Bringing God into your Situation – 1 Corinthians 10:31-33

We're either glorying God or we're glorifying someone else. Usually that "someone else" is our self.

Here are three practical ways you can glorify God in all situations:

1. **Tense** situations, problems, and disagreements allow us to glorify God – how, by practicing love and forgiveness.
2. We **trust** God enough to follow Him wherever He leads, even if the path looks difficult. Cancer, family, financial challenges – all provide opportunities to trust Christ.
3. We **obey** God by daily faithfulness – we live by a daily grind. We glorify God by obeying Him – it reveals our allegiance.

When we seek to bring God into all our situations, we become less results dependent. If something goes against us, we remain faithful to Him.

MORNING WORSHIP

The Bible's Greatest Chapter – Romans 8:31-39

This section is filled with questions that lead us to understand the workings of God is based upon His love for believers.

- It is possible to know our Bible yet be cold spiritually. We should be moved spiritually by God's love for us: what He did in Christ, and our opportunity to receive eternal salvation.
- Paul teaches us that God has done the hard thing, give up His Son Jesus, so we can be assured that He does the easier thing, "grant us everything." **v. 32**

When you stand for Scripture, live a godly life, trust in Him throughout all circumstances – who can be against you?

In all situations we find ourselves in: we honor God. Taking the high road is the Christian way.

- We live among hardship and pain, but we must not allow hardship and pain define us.
- Many believers are drinking the poison of bitterness, while hoping another person dies.

Paul quotes **Psalm 44:22** – we identify with Christ, not a defeated unbeliever.

God uses our suffering for our **good** and His **glory**. We should not let trials deceive us. God's love for us also confirms His eternal security – His love isn't based on circumstances and human action.

→ We are more than conquerors. No one can bring any charge against any believer in the court of heaven.

→ Paul listed ten things that cannot separate us from the love of Christ. Romans 8 concludes with God's love for us is the driving factor in our salvation, which is rooted in His character.
