

MORNING WORSHIP

What is Means to Have God's Grace – Luke 2:39-52

What is God's Grace?

Grace is receiving favor we don't deserve. Grace is what inclines God to give gifts that are free and undeserved by sinners. Undeserved favor.

Romans 3:24 "They are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus."

Joseph and Mary are model parents. They are always obeying God, even through angels and dreams.

How were Jesus' parents responsible?

- They were responsible with worship attendance.

Twelve year old Jesus had parents who brought Him to the Temple in Jerusalem for their annual pilgrimage to worship during Passover.

- They were responsible when Jesus was lost.

We do not see Joseph attacking Mary over lost Jesus. They responded to the danger of missing Jesus with **parental care, urgency, and love**.

They spent five days searching for Jesus. They did not stop looking for Him until He was found.

Jordan Peterson said, "You shouldn't do something for your children that they can do for themselves."

- Twelve year old Jesus is setting the course for His priorities. God is His Father. He makes it clear that His Father's business is His business.
- Jesus submits to His parents, yet He seeks God independently of His parents. He is showing us that young people can have a faith separate of their parents.
