

Come All Who Are Weary
Matthew 11:25-30

This section talks about laying all of your burdens down at the feet of Jesus:

Main Scripture - Matthew 11:25-30

- Verses 25–26: Jesus praises God for revealing truth to the humble, not just the wise.
- Verse 27: Jesus explains His authority and relationship with the Father.
- Verses 28–30: Jesus invites the weary to find rest in Him.
- His "yoke" is not easy in the sense of being carefree, but well-fitted.
- We are not alone—Jesus carries the heavy burden with us.

Parable of the Prodigal Son – Luke 15:11–24

- Younger son leaves home, squanders everything, returns in shame.
- Father runs to him, forgives him, and celebrates his return.
- Message: God is always ready to welcome us back with open arms.
- Luke 15:10: Heaven rejoices when one sinner repents.

Final Message

- Jesus will leave the 99 to find the one lost sheep.
- You don't have to fix everything yourself—lay your burdens at His feet.
