God's Future for Israel

In the Old Testament, Jews were saved by God declaring them,  
"righteous." This salvation was based on their belief in the Lord.  
**Genesis 15:6**

In the New Testament and today, Jews must be saved by faith in Jesus to  
go to heaven. **John 14:6**

Jews, who have not accepted Christ as their Messiah, are not saved.  
Being a descendant of Abraham doesn't get you into heaven.

Believers in Jesus have been grafted into Israel. Because of the Israel's  
disobedience and rejection of the Messiah, the Gospel extends to  
Gentiles. **Romans 11:17-24**

- There is a partial hardening of Jews, this is the rejection of Jesus,  
for the purpose of Gentiles getting saved. The Bible calls this a,  
"mystery." **Romans 11:25-26**
- Jesus said Israel wasn't willing to believe, and her house is now  
abandoned. **Luke 13:34-35**

During the Tribulation, the Third Temple will be rebuilt. Jerusalem will  
play a key role in the rise of the Anti-Christ. **Daniel 9:27; Matthew  
24:15-16, 21**



## God's Past for Israel

The Philistines, who are likely the Palestinians today, lived in the land of Canaan during the time of Abraham.

## Israel's Promise of the Land – **Genesis 11:27-12:9**

Abraham came from Shem (Noah's son). When someone says they're "Semitic" this is a reference that they descend from Shem.

- ☐ Abram's father is Terah – born in Ur of the Chaldeans. Ur is located in southern Iraq.
- ☐ Terah took Abram, Sarai, Lot (his grandson), and left for Canaan, following the Euphrates River, they stopped in Haran, which is in Southern Turkey.
- ☐ Terah passed away in Haran – after Terah's death, God appeared to Abram while still in Haran and tells him He will bless him and make him into a great nation.

Abram travels south to the land of Canaan (Israel), while in Shechem, Israel, God tells Abram that this land will be given to his offspring.

Abram first pitched his tent in Bethel, Israel – built an altar and called upon the name of the Lord.

Jacob, whom God would later rename, “Israel” was at Bethel, the same place as his grandfather. The Lord told Jacob that He would give his offspring the land he was on. **Genesis 28:10-15; 32:24-29**
