

1 *ST C OF HISTORY: CREATION*

Text: Genesis 1:1-2:3

SUMMARY—The first "C" in our "walk through history" is the creation of all things. In the book of Genesis, which means "beginnings," God tells us He created the heavens, the earth, and all that is in them in 6 normal-length days about 6,000 years ago. In this study, we will take a brief look at what happened on each of the creation days and compare creation week with an evolutionary perspective of origins. The implications of God as our Creator are astounding.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. The way the Earth is tilted in space determines our seasons, but what determines that a week is 7 days long?
2. How do we know the days of creation were regular-length (24-hour) days and not thousands or millions of years long?
3. When did dinosaurs first appear on Earth?
4. How does God as Creator affect you and the world you live in?
