Visitor Guidelines

The safety and well-being of our campers is the top priority of Pine Acres Youth Camp (PAYC) staff and volunteers. We welcome visitors to enjoy the wonderful atmosphere created at PAYC, both during our services and free times. In our effort to create a safe environment for our campers and to keep the focus of PAYC on the spiritual growth of our campers, all PAYC visitors must adhere to these guidelines:

1. All visitors must check in with camp management upon arrival to and departure from campgrounds each day. A sign-in will be available.
2. No meals, lodging, or amenities will be provided to PAYC visitors.
3. If you are visiting with children, they are your responsibility. Camp staff and volunteers are working hard to run PAYC for the enrolled campers and already have a great deal of responsibility. Any PAYC service or activity your child attends, you must be present and care for them.
4. Never remove a camper from campgrounds for any reason.
5. Please be aware of the PAYC schedule during your visit. Please be respectful of the scheduled events.
