Understand that every child will come to Promiseland Preschool with different social skills and learning behaviors, we strive to accomplish the following goals, with every child, by the end of the school year:

4 & 5 year olds:

- Trusting us as teachers
- Following rules and directions
- Sharing – willingly
- Sitting nicely for 5-7 minutes
- Standing and walking in a line
- Waiting their turn and raising their hand
- Table manners
- Picking up after themselves
- Self-sufficient bathroom skills (washing hands, button/zip on own, etc...)
- Learn simple Bible stories and scripture
- Learn colors and shapes
- Recognize numbers 1-10, count to 20
- Alphabet recognition and phonetic sounds
- Coloring in the lines
- Using scissors properly
- Learn right and left
- Learn weekdays

Four and five year olds also learn about the calendar, the weather, more accurate art skills (proper cutting, coloring in the lines, neater gluing, painting), music and rhythms. Field trips expose them to expected social behavior, outside the classroom, and fun events such as "Muffins for Moms", "Doughnuts for Dads", class programs and holiday parties help them learn beginning hospitality skills. Special guest speakers and book readers help develop a love for learning and reading. Exposure to God's love and lessons develop a desire to learn more about Him. Prayer requests and individual prayers teach these precious promises that God cares about them, that He listens to their prayers and wants to guide and protect them.

We will communicate with parents, throughout the year, on each child's progress in these areas. Understanding that 4 and 5 year olds have a broad range of acceptable learning levels, but also with kindergarten readiness as a goal, we will work with you, the parent, to be sure you are comfortable with the progress your child is making as he/she prepares to successfully enter the elementary academic world.
