



Take time to be a blessing to a ministry that you know and love. We have projects suitable for all ages and skill levels. Many projects can be completed in a few hours, or day. We have a few major multi-day jobs requiring multiple skilled workers. Here are some of the things we need to complete in 2022:

Heavy Equipment

- Create appropriate grade for new sidewalk on the south end of the worship center
- Dig ditch for
 - new electrical run from box to the retreat center
 - new electrical run from boys dorms to southwest property for future bathrooms and lighting
 - electric from box to future covered pavilion
 - drain across retreat center entrance drive to relieve the sogginess on northwest corner of the parking area
 - across the center circle drive to run electric and water from the rv hookups into the center circle area, and
 - dig footers the for future building projects

Electrical Work

- Install a new electrical panel in the retreat center
- Wiring for retreat center kitchen expansion
- MPB kitchen outlet for serving line and future reach-in- fridge
- Work on swimming pool lights
- Miscellaneous exterior light fixtures changed out w/ LED motion activated lights.

Masonry Work

- Repair bricks on retreat center steps.
- Finish installation of rock in the worship center basement around the wood stove
- Install rock on the exterior walls of the worship center walk-out basement

Tree Removal

- Multiple dead trees
- Designated nuisance trees

Carpentry Work

- Install dorm shower doors
- Update trim in the fireplace room
- Design, create and build new sign for the retreat center entrance
- Doorway to connect/expand offices
- MPB Serving line

Miscellaneous

- Repair patio heaters
- Weather strip interior and exterior doors
- Reinforce retreat center floor joists in anticipation of kitchen expansion
- Declutter, organize and build shelves
- Brush clearing and burning
- General grounds work
