WHATCHA' THINKING?

John 6

- 1. In the spirit of "whatcha' thinking?," is there a single chapter in the Bible that you have consistently been intrigued by, or challenged by, in your life? (Describe).
- 2. We glanced briefly at two recent studies. The takeaway from the first is that for the most part people from *all* faiths think favorably about Jesus. In the second, the key takeaway is that nearly half of self-professed Christians believe that if they are *generally* good, that will be sufficient to make it into Heaven. How do these studies overlap? What is the danger of vectoring Christianity into a works-based faith?
- 3. Read Deuteronomy 18:15. Now read John 6:14-15. How did the people get so turned around that they resolved to make Jesus a king "by force"? In what ways do we try to conform Jesus to our own expectations or agendas?
- 4. Read John 6:26. In short order, the people went from being blessed by Jesus' provision to feeling entitled to more from Jesus? Do you struggle with a sense of entitlement on what you expect from God? What is the "antidote" to entitlement?
- 5. Read John 6:28-30. Is it difficult for you to accept that salvation is "by grace, through faith" period? Why is "by grace, through faith" so difficult for almost half of Christians still today?
- 6. In your own words, what does it mean that Jesus is "the bread of life?" (John 6:35).
- 7. Read John 6:66-69. What saddens you about what you read here? What encourages you? What does this inspire in you?
