3. Vision can both inspire hope and raise doubts. How can vision remain red hot, even in seasons of waiting for vision to come to fruition?
4. Read Revelation 7:9-12 aloud, and slowly. What does this heavenly vision inspire in you?
5. How might our vision bring us closer to the ultimate vision in Revelation 7?
6. What excites you about our vision? What concerns you?
7. Why are “output” and “impact” measures essential to track? What do you think we should begin to measure?
8. Our 2026 theme is *“A Year of Stories.”* Share a few stories in your group about how you sense God working in your life, and/or in the life of our church.
