The Gospel of Jesus Christ

1 Cor. 15:1-11

1. What would you say the church should stand for?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. What do you hear Paul saying the church should stand for?
3. Paul says first off, the church should stand for the truth that Christ died for our sins (v3).
4. We talked about a gap that exists between us and God. What was the only way we talked about to get across that gap? Do you agree with this?
5. We also mentioned that most people respond to this gap in two ways. What were those two ways (hint: we used the words wrong and sin).
6. We heard on Sunday that the bible says we are all sinners. Do you agree? Why or why not?
7. We learned more about the word Tetelestai. What does this word mean and why did we bring it up on Sunday?
8. We said on Sunday that the second thing we should stand on is the truth that Christ was buried and raised (v4). Discuss this with someone.
9. Read Mark 16:6, 1 Corinthians 15:22, and Romans 6:4. What do these verses contribute to this message?
10. We said that the final thing we are to stand on is the truth that Christ appeared (v5). Read vv5-8 again to see how many people Jesus appeared to.
11. Read Acts 1:3. What did you read?
12. We ended our message on Sunday by saying that there are three reasons why Jesus returned after his death. What were the three reasons?
