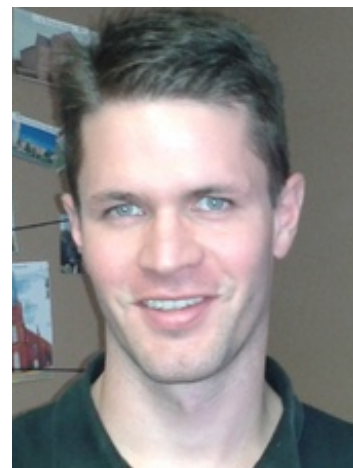
Dear Friend of Gabriel,

Mariel, why we do what we do!

Imagine being a successful working mom, owning your own home, with a steady job at one of the country's leading insurance firms. Picture yourself twelve years later, with four children, having been abandoned and abused by your military-service husband--and pregnant--after being abused by your "new boyfriend."

Imagine being Mariel.

Having lost her job and her home, Mariel is now unable to meet her monthly rent obligation of \$1400. She and her children will soon be homeless. It is particularly difficult for pregnant women to find respite in shelters, and Mariel has only a short time until she has to leave the Howard County shelter where she and her four children are staying.

Having lived through a series of horrific challenges, Mariel has chosen life-- even though the child she is carrying is a result of violence. She views her decision as the first of many with the goal of regaining independence and becoming self-sufficient.

We became aware of Mariel through a partnership with one of our thirty *Gabriel* churches. Right now, church-based Angel Friends are coming alongside Mariel--and many women like her--who need practical, emotional, physical and spiritual support.

Pregnant, and not willing to take the easy way out that an abortion would provide, Mariel will continue to need both immediate support and the long-term relationships that only our Angel Friend ministry can

provide through the love of many and the love of Jesus Christ.

Thank you for all that you do in support of Gabriel, Mariel, and the many women and children we serve.
