COWTOWN MARATHON THIS SUNDAY

INFORMATION TO ASSIST YOU

IN PLANNING YOUR ROUTE TO CHURCH THIS SUNDAY

Best routes to travel to church this Sunday:

Due to the running of the Cowtown Marathon several of the roads to St. Andrew's may be temporarily blocked. The best way to reach St. Andrew's tomorrow is to take the Cherry Street exit from Interstate 30 (which is accessible only when traveling eastbound on I-30). All the usual city streets will cause you to be stranded by street closures due to the Cowtown Marathon.

The suggested routes to St. Andrew's are:

Eastbound instructions:

- I-30
- Exit Cherry Street to downtown Fort Worth
- Turn East on W 7th and continue to church.

Westbound instructions:

- Head west on I-30 W
- Keep right at the Fork to continue on Chisholm Trail Pkwy
- Take the S University/W Vickery Blvd exit
- Use left lane to keep left at the fork and continue toward S University Dr
- Turn left onto S University Dr
- Turn left to merge onto Chisholm Trail Pkwy
- Take the exit toward Cherry St
- Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Cherry Street
- Continue onto Cherry St
- Turn East onto W 7th St

Hurricane Harvey Update

2/14/18

Good morning everyone hope you had a Happy Valentine's for you and yours!

The world has been spinning around our house and i am late getting a report out to you about my visit last week to Port Aransas but, better late than never! Here is what an update and time line and for our next step:

The fundraiser was very well attended and a good time was had by all. Fr Derkits thanked me (and you) profusely for our unwavering and committed support for them! He was ecstatic over the \$2500 check I handed him and numerous parishioners came up and offered thanks as well.



Regarding the fund raiser, interestingly enough, they have raised approximately \$1.6million toward their goal of \$1.9 million to not only build the Outreach Building but the new school building as well.

The “outreach” building is first up to get built and they essentially have enough to fund their estimated cost of \$300k in hand.

The School building will not take place until after outreach is done. Permits have been applied for, and they anticipate getting them in hand sometime mid to late March. Groundbreaking will occur after the permit is received, so if you want to be on hand, you might keep this window on your calendar open.

A general contractor has been hired, his name is Bill Gavit. The parish point person for this is Burt Moorhouse, whom I met last week. Word is these gentlemen are very well qualified and eager to get this done! We had a meeting on Friday morning with Burt Moorhouse, Johnie Swenson, and Fr. Derkits to discuss/plan how we can be of service and it looks like this:

- The building will be on piers, not a slab, and the General Contractor will be doing this.
 - Once the framing is completed, they would like us to assist in attaching the walls. Naturally we will be on hand to help anything else that comes up.
 - All of our work is going to be “under the guidance/supervision”of the project manager.
 - It appears our plan should be to arrive on Monday and stay the week, returning home on Friday.
 - Our best guess for when this might come up is late April to early May. Which is after “spring break” so we should be able to get accommodations with no problem.
 - Once we get through this phase, we can assess our next portion to work on, and the associated time line.
- Completion of the outreach building is expected to be August/September.

While there I visited with Nana at the Pre School and they are doing very well. She said they have a small amount of damaged furniture they might like to replace, i asked her to send details on what replacement furniture would cost etc and said perhaps we could help with that.
