Wycliffe Bible Translators

Dorcas Day, a member of our own St. Andrew's, has a long history with the church dating back to the early '90s. She and her son Charlie have served on long-term missionary assignments with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Southeast Asia, Central and South America. She has been based in North Carolina with JAARS, a partner organization with Wycliffe that provides technical support to communicate the Gospel to many in remote cultures through Bible Translation. Dorcas' role since 2007 has been translating materials for dubbing purposes of Bible history, movie scripts and other pertinent materials to reach out the oral community globally into the vernacular "heart language" of people groups. Her current assignment is serving as assistant to the Director of Language Programs for the Bibleless Peoples of Peru.
