

GOAL 6 ▶ Local Outreach

Our desire is to **engage 25–30 individuals** in local outreach by intentionally equipping and sending members of Cornerstone Bible Church into the community. Our focus includes:

- Actively train and send individuals from our church into the Lilburn area.
- Send individuals or teams to be actively sharing the Gospel of Jesus at **Good News Club**, Parkview High School, **NG3**, and the **GSA fields**.
- Establish new believer discipleship groups for those interested in learning more about their faith.



GOAL 3 ▶ Adult Sunday Academy

Our goal is to build a **five-year, intentional pathway** that helps people grow into **mature believers** through consistent, biblical teaching and practical discipleship. To accomplish this, we will establish an **Adult Sunday Academy** that offers the two weekly options:

- One Sunday Academy **Bible-focused class** centered on studying a book of the Bible, key doctrines of the faith, or a biblical character.
- One Sunday Academy **life-oriented class** that addresses common questions and challenges Christians face, with topics such as finances, spiritual gifts, parenting, social issues, politics, relationships, and more.
