Psalm 29:1-11

⁰ A Psalm of David. ¹ Give unto the LORD, O you mighty ones, give unto the LORD glory and strength. ² Give unto the LORD the glory due to His name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

³ The voice of the LORD is over the waters; the God of glory thunders; the LORD is over many waters. ⁴ The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty. ⁵ The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars, yes, the LORD splinters the cedars of Lebanon. ⁶ He makes them also skip like a calf, Lebanon and Sirion like a young wild ox. ⁷ The voice of the LORD divides the flames of fire. ⁸ The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; the LORD shakes the Wilderness of Kadesh. ⁹ The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth, and strips the forests bare; and in His temple everyone says, "Glory!"

¹⁰ The LORD sat enthroned at the Flood, and the LORD sits as King forever. ¹¹ The LORD will give strength to His people; the LORD will bless His people with peace.

I. Give Glory:

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(vv1-2).

- **In the Bible, "glory" (Hebrew: *kavod*, Greek: *doxa*) refers to the weighty presence, splendor, greatness, and absolute worth of God.** It signifies the visible manifestation of His character and power, such as bright light or fire. It reveals who He truly is and demands our honor and ultimate worship.

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V. Questions:

- **Question #1: "If God's voice commands everything, why doesn't He just fix everything now?"**
 - God's power is not delayed. It is purposeful as He patiently works out His plan in perfect wisdom (*2 Peter 3:9*). One day He will bring justice and restore all things, so we trust His timing even now (*Ephesians 1:11; Revelation 21:4*).
- **Question #2: "If God controls everything, why do I still go through storms?"**
 - God does not promise the absence of storms. He promises His presence in them (*Isaiah 43:2*). The same voice that rules the storm gives strength and peace to His people as He brings them through it (*Psalms 29:11*).
- **Question #3: "If God's voice is this powerful, why don't I feel it in my life?"**
 - God's voice is not dependent on your feelings, it is always active and guiding through His Word (*John 10:27; Psalm 119:105*). The real question is not if God is speaking, but whether you are listening and responding in faith.
