⁰ To the Chief Musician. With stringed instruments. On an eight-stringed harp. A Psalm of David. ¹ O LORD, do not rebuke me in Your anger, nor chasten me in Your hot displeasure. ² Have mercy on me, O LORD, for I am weak; O LORD, heal me, for my bones are troubled. ³ My soul also is greatly troubled; but You, O LORD—how long? ⁴ Return, O LORD, deliver me!
