1. Read verses 3-12.
2. Why is it so important for Christians to hold on to sound teaching?
3. Why does false doctrine tend to produce the evils of verses 3-4?
4. Have you ever seen godliness *connected to* financial gain? Explain what that looked like and how you felt about it.
5. Why is “godliness with contentment” great gain?
6. When you think about what Jesus had to say about money and wealth, what stands out for you?
7. Reread verse 8. Is it true for you?
8. What warnings are given against loving money?
9. Why is the love of money such an issue for many people? How can we avoid this problem?
10. List some of the things you’ve pursued in life. How does righteousness rank among them?
11. Verse 11 lists several words that are part of righteousness. Which of these would you really like to see more of in your life?
12. In your own words, what does it mean to “fight the good fight of faith”?
13. Read verses 17-19.
14. How does the end of verse 17 *push back against* feeling guilty if you have wealth?
15. Instead of feeling guilty, or being self-indulgent, what should we do with our wealth?
16. According to verse 19, what does this gain for us?
