Sermon Title: A Trustworthy Saying

Scripture: 2 Timothy 2:11-13

1. Verse 11 quotes “a trustworthy saying.” What *trustworthy sayings* have you heard that are often repeated?
2. It’s believed that these three verses were a part of an early Christian hymn. What Christian hymn or song has the Lord used to bless you? What made the lyrics so meaningful to you?
3. How would you describe what it means to “die with Him”? Why is such an all-in word like “*die*” used to describe belief in Jesus?
4. Would you say that the role of a substitute is an easy one? If someone in your group has been a substitute teacher, have them describe what that was like.
5. Why is it important for Jesus to be our *representative on the cross* as well as our *substitute*?
6. Read Galatians 2:20. How does this help us better understand Vs. 11?
7. What does it mean to “live with him”?
8. Why is endurance such an important part of the Christian faith?
9. What other areas of life also require endurance to achieve great results?
10. Any advice for someone who struggles with endurance?
11. When you think of *reigning* with Christ, what do you picture for yourself and others in your small group?
12. How does 1 John 2:19 and the Parable of the Sower (Luke 8:13) help us better understand those who disown Jesus?
13. What events in the Apostle Peter’s life proved the truth of verse 13?
14. How does the story of the Prodigal Son compare?
15. How have you seen Jesus prove faithful even when you or someone else was faithless?
16. Verse 15 says, “He cannot disown Himself.” What does this mean?
17. How does this week’s study *challenge* you? *Encourage* you?
