3. What are some Biblical examples of a lack of peace? Worldly examples?
4. Why do you think peace is often so hard to come by?
5. Read Chapter 2:11-22.
6. How are the Gentiles described before Christ came? The Jews?
7. Why does the “blood of Christ” bring Gentiles near?
8. Why do you think peace is such a reoccurring theme in the New Testament?
9. How does the cross “put to death” the hostility between Jews and Gentiles?
10. What does it mean to you to have access to the Father by one Spirit?
11. How do verses 19 and 20 really affirm us as Christians?
12. Is referring to the church as a “holy temple” evident? Why or why not?
13. Vs. 22 says we are “being built together,” what does this mean?
14. Is it possible to be in a place of turmoil and uncertainty, and still be at peace? How?
