5. When you think of the Apostle Paul's life, how did this verse come true?
6. READ Verses 8-9. Verse 8 portrays a very humble Paul. Why is this a good thing? How might humility take a step too far?
7. READ Verses 14-19. What are some of the spiritual blessings Paul prays for?
8. What are some of the truths about love mentioned in this section?
9. Having the power of the Spirit in us is brought up again and again in this section. Why is that so important?
10. Based on verse 21, what is the ultimate goal of everything God is doing in and through us and for us? Why is that the ultimate goal?
