1. When it comes to *making it right*, how do you rate on a scale of 1 to 10 (with 10 being quick to make it right)? What holds you back?
2. Read Matthew 26:69-75
3. Why do you think Peter shifted so quickly from his willingness to fight for Jesus that he showed in the Garden of Gethsemane?
4. What stands out for you in Peter's denial of the Lord?
5. When Peter went out and wept bitterly, do you think contrition was part of his tears? What do you think was going through his mind?
6. Read 1 John 1:9. Why is this a verse everyone should take to heart?
7. How do Luke 24:12 and John 21:7 contrast with Peter denying the Lord? What does this tell us about him? How can we be the same?
8. Read John 21:15-19
9. What is Jesus doing to make it right with Peter? How would this affirm Peter's role as an Apostle?
10. What about Jesus' challenge to Peter speaks to you?
11. Read Acts 2:29-41 and Acts 4:8-20
12. How does the Peter of Acts compare to the Peter who denied Jesus three times?
13. Peter crumbled with fear when called out by a slave girl, but now stands boldly before the Jewish officials and High Priest. Why the dramatic change?
14. Do you think "making it right" with the Lord should include taking a stand for Him?
15. How have this week's passages and discussion challenged you?
