## *Discussion Questions*

**Sermon Title:** Saved for Good

**Sermon Date:** May 21, 2017

**Scripture:** Titus 3

**Speaker:** Pastor Rod Randall

1. Read 3:1-11
2. Pastor Rod began his sermon by focusing on the word “saved” from verse 5. Have group members give a very brief explanation (1-2 minutes) of how they got saved.
3. Do you think verse 3 gives an accurate description of mankind?
4. READ Luke 7:36-50. Based on this passage, why are some people blind to their own need for salvation?
5. How would you respond to someone who said, “As long as you’re a good person, you’ll go to heaven?”
6. What ultimately brought about salvation for mankind? What didn’t? Based on what we read about people in verse 3, why is God’s response so amazing?
7. Titus 3:4-7 lists many of the blessings that come with salvation. What are they? What means the most to you?
8. What does the phrase, “rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit” mean to you?
9. Can you share a time when the presence of the Spirit in your life was obvious?
10. How are we to respond to so great a salvation?
11. Titus mentions again and again the importance of doing good. Any recent stories of “doing what is good” that you can share?
12. Why is it good “to be subject to rulers and authorities?” Have you ever been a part of a government protest? Is there ever a place for civil disobedience?
13. When it comes to doing good, we read words like, “be ready” (3:1), “eager” (2:14), and “devote themselves” (3:8). Does this seem like a tall order? How can we live up to this?
14. How did Jesus and His disciples quickly gain a reputation as those who do good?
15. If you were to do something “good” for the Lord, what would that look like? What about something good for your family? Spouse? Friends? Co-workers? Enemies?
