Read 1 Peter 2:4-12

1. When you think of a priest, what is the first thing that comes to mind?
2. Based on verse 5, Christians are described as a “holy priesthood.” How should that impact us? Do you think most Christians see themselves in this way? Why or why not?
3. What are some examples of “spiritual sacrifices” as mentioned in verse 5?
4. What does it mean to have Jesus Christ as the cornerstone of your life?
5. Verse 6 uses the phrase “trusts in him.” When did you first trust in Jesus? Do you think there’s a difference between big picture eternal trust and practical everyday trust? In what areas does your trust need to grow?
6. How do you care for and protect belongings that really mean a lot to you? Examples? Verse 9 which says we are “a people belonging to God.” What comparisons can be made?
7. Verse 10 says that Christians are called “into His wonderful light.” Why is this such an appropriate metaphor?
8. What other Bible verses use the word “light” and what point is being made?
9. To be human is to experience the attack of “sinful desires” (Vs. 11). Which ones tend to attack you? Any thoughts on how to win the battle and abstain?
10. What is the outcome of doing good deeds based on verse 12? Why do people respond this way?
11. Spend some time brainstorming about good deeds you can do, either individually or as a group.
