1. When you hear the phrase, "The end is near," what comes to mind? What should this motivate us to do?
2. Why is prayer an important response? Why does prayer require being clear minded and self-controlled?
3. The title verse says, "Above all, love each other deeply." How can we live this out?
4. When the Bible says, "Love covers over a multitude of sins," what does that mean? What doesn't it mean? Any personal stories about this?
5. Verse 9 says to "Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling." Compare Luke 14:12-14, Matthew 10:40-42, and Hebrews 13:2. Why is hospitality such a reoccurring theme? How can we get past our hesitancy to show hospitality?
6. The topic of spiritual gifts comes up in verse 10. Compare Romans 12:4-8 and 1 Corinthians 12:7-11. What are your spiritual gifts? If you aren't sure, take one of the free spiritual gift tests found online. Why does God give us spiritual gifts? Any examples of using your spiritual gifts?
7. How can we make sure we speak, "the very words of God"?
8. How can we serve with His strength?
9. What's the end goal of all the things talked about in this lesson?
