Sermon Title: No Other Name

Sermon Date: October 14, 2018

Scripture: Acts 4:12

As an opener, share any stories surrounding group member names. Who were you named after? Why?

1. In this week's lesson we will see why the name of Jesus is essential for salvation. In contrast to that, the idea that all religions lead to God is common these days. Why is this a popular view?
2. READ John 14:6. Why would this have been an offensive statement to the Jews? Why is it offensive to many people today? How has Jesus proved Himself to be "the way, the truth, and the life" to you? Why is access to the Father available only through Jesus?
3. READ Acts 4:8-20. How does Peter back up what Jesus said about Himself? What can we learn from the religious leaders' response? How does the stand taken by Peter and John speak to you?
4. READ Colossians 1:15 and 2:9. What do these passages teach us about Jesus? How is He unique compared to all other human beings?
5. READ Philippians 2:5-7. This passage affirms what about Jesus? Even though we can't be just like Jesus (fully divine and fully human), we are challenged to have the same "mind" or "attitude" as He did. What does this look like for you?
6. READ John 10:30-33. What claim does Jesus make about Himself? How does He back it up? Talk over the similarity between how the Jews respond to Jesus and how people in our day respond.
7. READ John 14:7-11. Jesus repeats the claim about Himself that He made in John 10. Why do you think Philip was slow to catch on? Was there a time when you were slow to catch on? What changed?
8. READ Romans 2:23, 6:23 and Ephesians 2:1. What do these verses teach us about sin and its consequence?
9. According to Romans 3:24-25 and 5:8-9 what solution to sin does God provide and how?
10. READ Acts 2:32. Why is the resurrection so important to the Christian faith? What other Bible verses speak to this issue?
11. READ Acts 20:27, Luke 19:11 and Revelation 3:20. How do these verses show that Jesus pursues people so they might be saved?
12. What are ways you have seen Jesus pursue you? How might this week's lesson give you a new appreciation for who Jesus is and what He has done?
