Read 2 Peter 1:3-8

1. According to the Harvard Business Review, we need less sugar, private jets, blaming, super sizes, possessions, constructive criticism, texting, inequality. What would you add to the list?
2. Verse 3 makes a big statement about God providing for our needs. Have you found this to be true? In what ways?
3. In addition to “life” God provides all we need to be “godly.” What does this mean? What aspect of godliness would you like to see develop in you?
4. Why does everything we need for life and godliness come through our knowledge of Jesus?
5. List a few of God’s “very great and precious promises.” Which ones mean the most to you? What Bible verses come to mind?
6. What does it mean to participate in the divine nature? How might focusing on this change the way we approach each day?
7. Verse 4 says that the corruption in the world is caused by evil desires. How do you know which of your desires are of the Lord and which are not?
8. What does the phrase “make every effort” tell us about the Christian faith?
9. Look at the list of words in verses 5-7. Which ones challenge you the most? Any practical insights on how to “add” these? Why is it so important that we do?
