READ 2 Peter 3:3-13

1. Given the choice, would you rather spring forward or fall back? Why?
2. They say the older you get; the faster time goes. Agree/disagree?
3. What does 3:8 teach us about God's perspective of time compared to ours? How can this verse help us when we are frustrated with God's timing?
4. What time-related promise is made in Ecclesiastes 3:11? Why can Christians truly say, "Time is on our side"?
5. The second coming of Christ has yet to occur, not because God is slow, but because He is patient. What's the difference?
6. Why are people often so slow to repent? What does God's patience tell us about Him?
7. When you look at your life, would you say it's more about you waiting on God, or God waiting on you?
8. Why does the "day of the Lord" come as a thief and with such catastrophic events? How does knowing, "everything will be destroyed in this way," motivate us to "live holy and godly lives"?
9. Picture yourself living a much more holy and godly life. What do you see? What changes do you need to make to get there?
10. Verse 13 says, "We are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth." What are you looking forward to the most?
