Read 1 John 2:1-10

1. Have you ever had anyone speak up in your defense? What might Jesus say when He speaks to the Father in your defense?
2. Verse 2 describes Jesus as the “atoning sacrifice for our sins.” What does this mean?
3. According to this passage, knowing Jesus and obedience to Jesus go hand in hand. Why?
4. How does obedience to the Word lead to the completion of God’s love in a person?
5. Compare John 15:10. What did Jesus model for us and what happened as a result?
6. When you read the phrase, “Walk as Jesus did,” what comes to mind?
7. Why is having hatred for a brother described as walking in darkness? When you hate someone, what are you blind to?

READ Verses 15-17

1. How do you live with the tension of being in the world but not of it, or liking the world but not loving it?
2. Verse 16 helps us understand worldliness. What three things are a part of it? Read Matthew 4:1-11 about the temptation of Jesus. What similarities do you see? What can we learn from this?
3. List as many reasons as you can from these passages why we shouldn’t give in to worldly desires.
