2. Are you more apt to doubt or believe big news reports that come your way?
3. If you put yourself in Thomas' place, can you see yourself responding like he did? Why or why not?
4. In vs. 27 Jesus commands Thomas to, "Stop doubting and believe." When is Jesus apt to tell you the same thing?
5. How do we know that Thomas obeyed Jesus?

### **READ John 11:1-16**

6. What do you make of what Thomas says in vs. 16? Do you see it as him being fatalistic, full of faith, or something else?
7. How do you think the disciples would have viewed Thomas after this comment?

### **READ Matthew 17:22-23 and John 14:1.**

8. Based on these verses why was Thomas in the wrong by refusing to believe in the resurrection?
9. Why does doubting the Lord dishonor Him?
10. Have you ever let your doubts about the promises of God get the best of you?
11. How has doubt robbed you of the joy that you could have in Christ?
12. When you consider all that Thomas experienced in life, what else might he share with you if he was your mentor for a moment?
