Frequently Asked Questions

- **Where will we be working?**
Community Church of Chesapeake & First Baptist South Hill, along with the Civic League and Chesapeake Police serve the neighborhoods of Crestwood Manor & Old Crestwood, and the schools associated with the Crestwood Community.
- **What will we be doing?**
We will be organized into teams that focus on yards, cleaning, painting, repairs & visitation. Some volunteers will help with daily meals or the Celebration Event. We will assign volunteers into teams based on your skills, interests, availability, & of course the work that needs to be done.
- **What is a typical day like during Serve the City?**
Our day begins at 8am at Crestwood Intermediate School (CIS) with team devotions, prayer & assignments. Lunch will be served each day at CIS. Monday will be a full day with volunteer orientation in the morning and work in the afternoon. Tues. - Fri. workdays will end after lunch except for some limited repair work.
- **What if I can't work all week or a full day?**
That's ok! We have several projects & teams working each day throughout the week. Volunteers are encouraged to work as many days & even all week if possible. But if you can't, just let us know the times that you ARE available & we'll use you then.
- **What about meals?**
We will serve lunch to the volunteers each day at CIS. We will also serve dinner Monday and Thursday evenings.
- **What ages can help with Serve the City?**
Ages 9 - 12 are welcome to participate on a STC team, under direct supervision or on the same team as their parent(s) / guardian(s).
Teens (13 & older) will be assigned to a team along with other volunteers.
- **Can families with younger children serve together?**
Families with children age 8 & younger can serve together doing family projects. If you are interested in learning about family projects, contact Lori Rosie at 377-8177 or children@ccconfire.org
- **Will someone be available to watch my children while I work?**
We do not provide child care. We encourage you to work with other interested families from your church to arrange childcare in your homes. Contact your Church Representative for details.
- **What should I wear?**
The neighborhood knows us by our bright green T-shirts, so we ask that every volunteer wear this on every job. If you don't have a STC T-shirt or would like another one, they can be purchased for \$10.00. **The deadline to order t-shirts is May 26**
For safety purposes, we require closed-toe shoes while working in the homes & yards and recommend long pants.
