Why it matters

There are a number of reasons that building this Dining Hall will matter at Indian Creek. As detailed earlier, it will add many opportunities to serve larger groups in the off-season, provide a comfortable and safe space during the summer for any inclement weather, and most importantly provide an up-to-date space for the powerful fellowship around a table that happens all summer long.

Since 2015, we've been cooking in one building, and eating in another with about 200 yards in between the two. While our staff has become very efficient with the process, it is a cumbersome burden to our daily activity and a hindrance to many other things. This process of transporting food takes around 30 minutes, before and after, each meal for 3-4 staff people. This time and energy would be completely eliminated from the schedule when a new hall is available, and the food, utensils, cups, trays, condiments, and other supplies will simply be moved from the cooking space to the serving line only 20 feet apart. The free time provided will allow the staff to have a defined devotional time together, and staff meeting so that we're on the same page. It will also allow for staff to be more present with campers during their meal time, workshops, and activity times that surround each meal. This small change will have a huge impact on the spirit, and availability of the staff, and directors throughout the summer season.

Beyond the summer, this Dining Hall will provide a myriad of opportunities to serve you all year long. In addition to the events mentioned earlier, we will continue to build revenue through year round events, and continue to grow the number and size of groups we serve. All of this is a benefit to the camping ministry as a whole here at Indian Creek. As always, we are driven by the 3 tenants of our Vision. Everything we do will be built on the idea that it must create an opportunity to Connect-Refresh-Grow with Jesus and others.

More important than anything else, this building matters because it's so much more than wood and steel. It becomes a living space filled with the Holy Spirit, and where the Power of Jesus and His Love is shared for all to hear. The stories we will share, and the memories made in this new building will be the ones that change history, and alter the legacy of our lives both now and into eternity.
