CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

Parking Welcome to Indian Creek! Please park on one of the asphalt pads, or in the gravel, and make your way to the Chapel. Please leave luggage in the car, and only bring medicine to the Chapel

(The Chapel is the stone building with the green roof on the left of the main road coming into camp - It has a stoplight between the doors)

Enter Chapel Upon entry, each camper will receive an item with a number on it. This number will be called to come up to the main table, and meet the session Director. Enjoy the music and images on the screen for more information about your week of camp.

The only thing you need to bring with you to the chapel is Medicine, and balance due payments

Check in The Session Director will give your camper their cabin assignment, and other information about the week, then you will proceed to the nurse to check in your meds, and medical information.

It is vital that you communicate any medical needs, (physical, emotional, or mental) to the nurse, so that we can take care of your camper in every way.

Head Check We understand that this can be a stressful experience for your camper. It is vital that we prevent the spread of lice in our camp. If there is the presence of lice at any stage (live, dead, nits, empty nit sacks) then we are required to dismiss your camper. At that time, we will share with you options for return.

We encourage you to have a hair care professional, or school nurse check your camper the day before you are to attend camp.

Enjoy You may now return to your vehicle, and drive to your cabin. Please take the time to talk to your cabin leader, and share with them anything about your camper they might need to know (sleepwalking, bedwetting, social issues, etc.)
