

Volunteers working directly with children are strongly encouraged to complete the PA Mandated Reporter Course every five years.

Steps to complete the training:

1. Go to <https://www.reportabusepa.pitt.edu>
2. Create a username and password. Click Registration at the top of the page. OR use one that you have already established if you have previously completed this training online
3. Complete the PA Mandated Reporter Course. You do not need to complete in in one sitting. You are able to logout and when you return, log back in & the course will pick up where you left off.
4. Upon completion, print out the certificate, keeping one for your file and provide the church office with a copy.
